NEW YORK | REAL ESTATE

Deficiencies in Action Not Enough to Defeat Motion for Receiver

Plaintiff sought to foreclose on a CEMA Mortgage encumbering parcels of improved real property. Plaintiff commenced the action where it alleged defendants defaulted in repayment of the note. Plaintiff moved for the appointment of a temporary receiver of the rents of the mortgaged premises. Mortgagor and guarantor defendants opposed the motion. The motion was granted. The court held the claim that unpled defenses and other purported deficiencies in its action defeats this motion was without merit. A plaintiff may apply for the appointment of a receiver, without notice and without regard for adequacy of the security for the debt.

KINGS | MEDICAL MALPRACTICE

Summary Judgment Denied; Issues of Fact Concerning Injury During Childbirth

A medical malpractice action involving shoulder dystocia during childbirth, defendants moved for summary judgment on behalf of the patient's private ob/gyn and the hospital's physicians. The court found the movant's expert opinions on the standard of care were conclusory and based on unestablished facts, as the records and testimony were inconsistent on the role of various physicians in the delivery. On proximate causation, the court also found issues of fact based on the conflicting opinions not only of the parties' experts, but the defendant physicians' depositions. The court denied summary judgment to the hospital defendants for these reasons. The Court also denied summary judgment to the private ob/gyn, who had adopted the co-defendants' expert affirmation.

SECOND CIRCUIT | CRIMINAL APPEALS

Panel Vacates Supervised-Release Conditions, Modifies Internet-Monitoring Condition

Defendant was convicted of one count of travel with the intent to engage in illicit sexual conduct. On appeal, defendant challenged four discretionary conditions of supervised release that were imposed as part of his sentence. Two of the conditions were imposed pursuant to "General Order #23," a standing order that, at the time of defendant's sentencing, required district courts in the NDNY to impose 15 conditions of supervised release as "standard conditions" in all cases imposing a term of supervised release. The Second Circuit determined that the district court erred by imposing those two discretionary supervised-release conditions without making the required individualized assessment or articulating on the record its reasons for imposing the conditions. However, the panel rejected defendant's challenge to two other conditions that were related to mandatory internet monitoring and a ban on adult pornography, finding no plain error, although the panel struck the portion of the internet-monitoring condition that impermissibly delegated authority to limit defendant to a single device.

FCRA Claim Against Credit Reporting Company Dismissed for Lack of Verifiable Inaccuracy

Plaintiff brought an action against Top Line Reporting for alleged violations of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) and the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA), claiming that Top Line placed a false debt on her credit report and failed to reasonably investigate her disputes concerning that alleged debt. Specifically, plaintiff contended that Top Line falsely reported a \$3,820 debt to Trans Union, failed to investigate her disputes, and harmed her credit, including causing a denial of an Apple Credit Card. Top Line moved for judgment on the pleadings only as to the FCRA claim. The court granted Top Line's motion, determining that plaintiff failed to allege an "objectively and readily verifiable" inaccuracy of the disputed debt, a threshold requirement for an FCRA claim against furnishers, making the adequacy of Top Line's investigation irrelevant. The court acknowledged that while plaintiff was probably right that Top Line's efforts to verify Trans Union's reporting of the disputed debt were cursory and insufficient, the sufficiency of Top Line's investigation was irrelevant because plaintiff failed to allege an actionable inaccuracy.

KINGS | MEDICAL MALPRACTICE

Summary Judgment Granted and Denied In Part in Medical Malpractice Action

Eighteen-year-old Luis Torres was presented to the emergency department of Wyckoff Heights Medical Center with left knee pain and swelling. After several more visits to the hospital, EMS brought Mr. Torres to Woodhull Hospital, where he was diagnosed with osteosarcoma. On March 9, 2013, Mr. Torres passed away at Woodhull Hospital. An action was brought and defendants moved for summary judgment. The motion was denied and granted in part. The court held defendants established the action was commenced more than two and a half years after all but Mr. Torres' last visit to Wyckoff on September 4, 2012. Plaintiffs' claims against defendants were dismissed with prejudice. As to defendant doctor, plaintiffs failed to raise questions of fact as to whether the continuous treatment doctrine should toll the statute of limitations period.

Defendants Summary Judgment Granted As Plaintiff Did Not Appear for EUO

After oral argument, defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment was granted and plaintiff's cross motion for summary judgment was denied. Plaintiff established that it timely mailed the bills at issue to defendant. After receiving the bills, defendant timely noticed examinations under oath ("EUO") of the plaintiff by letters. Defendant further established that plaintiff failed to appear for EUOs after the previously agreed upon reschedule. Plaintiff's second request for a reschedule the day before the scheduled EUO premised upon ongoing negotiations was not agreed upon by defendant and thus not rescheduled. An EUO reschedule cannot be unilateral. Rather, it must be agreed upon, in which it was not so done. Plaintiff contacted defendant and requested the EUO be scheduled in September 2021 and then November 2021, of which defendant agreed and accommodated to do so, accordingly scheduling the EUOs for September 23, 2021 and November 16, 2021, respectively.

Court in Securities Class Action Appoints Lead Plaintiff, Lead Counsel Under the PSLRA

In 2025, plaintiff Indiana Public Retirement System (INPRS) filed a putative class action against Inspire Medical Systems, Inc. The putative class consists of all investors who acquired Inspire common stock between Aug. 6, 2024 and Aug. 4, 2025, inclusive. Plaintiff moved for appointment as lead plaintiff and for approval of its attorneys as lead counsel. Both motions were unopposed. The court appointed INPRS as lead plaintiff and its attorneys as lead counsel under the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act (PSLRA), which governs motions for appointment of lead plaintiff and approval of lead counsel in putative class actions brought under federal securities laws and directs the court to appoint as lead plaintiff the party or parties "most capable of adequately representing the interests of class members." The court found plaintiff timely moved for appointment, had the largest financial interest in the case (approximately \$2 million in alleged losses), and satisfied Rule 23's typicality and adequacy requirements. In approving plaintiff's selection of its attorneys, the court cited the firm's extensive experience in securities class action litigation.

NY Plaintiff's Crypto Suit Against AL Defendants Dismissed for Lack of Jurisdiction

Pro se plaintiff, a New York resident, brought an action against entities that have their principal place of business in Alabama, alleging common law violations related to a cryptocurrency matter. Plaintiff asserted that the defendants, operators of a cryptocurrency exchange, engaged in fraud and gross negligence that caused him to lose over \$900,000 in his BolsaDX account. Plaintiff chiefly argued that defendant BolsaDX, a cryptocurrency exchange, had sufficient contacts with New York through its website. The court found that plaintiff relied on "group pleading" without distinguishing each defendant's actions and failed to show that the defendants had sufficient contacts with New York. The court noted that the interactive BolsaDX website and general accessibility to U.S. users were insufficient to establish personal jurisdiction, and plaintiff did not plausibly allege that the defendants expected their actions to have consequences in New York. Accordingly, the court granted the defendants' motion to dismiss but declined to impose sanctions on plaintiff, as the court did not find that the problems with the complaint were "patently clear."

Case Stayed After Finding Defendant's Counsel was Suspended From Practice

Two actions were commenced by plaintiff against defendants, alleging breaches of merchant cash advance contracts. Defendants' counsel submitted a document withdrawing as counsel in one of the actions, but not in the other. Plaintiff's counsel alerted the court and requested an adjournment of its pending summary judgment motions to serve the motion papers on the defendants themselves. Defendants' counsel had been suspended from the practice of law by the Appellate Division, Second Department. The court dismissed him from representing the defendants in the action where he did not withdraw. A stay was imposed and plaintiff's counsel was ordered to serve defendants with a copy of the court's decision-order.

Motion to Present Hearsay Statements In Matrimonial Action Denied

In a contested matrimonial action where there was one unemancipated child of the marriage, a motion in limine was filed by defendant-wife on the eve of trial, seeking ten different prongs of relief, being both denied in part and granted in part, after review by the court. However, one request sought an Order of the court permitting two witnesses to testify regarding out-of-court statements allegedly made by the parties' child, which related to alleged ongoing abuse by the plaintiff-father. In support, defendant-wife cited to New York State Family Court Act §§ 1001 and 1046(a)(vi) which set forth the purposes of child protective proceedings under Article 10 of the FCA. The court denied defendant's application. The court held the subject matter pending before the court was not commenced pursuant to Article 10 of the FCA which is the statutory basis for the hearsay exception at issue. Shortly after modifying custody, defendant-wife made clear that she was seeking a further modification of the modified custody agreement, which was an issue that now needs to be resolved at trial.

FCRA Claims Against Capital One Dismissed For Failure to Allege Negligence, Willfulness

Plaintiffs purchased a 2020 BMW from Victory Mitsubishi in 2024, with financing initially approved. Victory Mitsubishi later pressured plaintiffs to sign new documents and demanded larger payments, ultimately repossessing the car. During this time, Victory Mitsubishi requested that Capital One Auto Finance, a division of Capital One NA, access one plaintiff's credit reports in 2024, after the loan was already approved. Plaintiffs alleged that these credit pulls, which included both hard and soft inquiries, harmed plaintiff's credit score and occurred without notice, forming the basis of their claims under the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) against Capital One. The court granted Capital One's motion to dismiss, holding that the complaint failed to plausibly allege negligence or willfulness under Section 1681b(f) of the FCRA. The court also concluded that no private right of action exists under Section 1681m of the Equal Credit Opportunity Act, which requires anyone who takes an adverse action with respect to a consumer "based in whole or in part on any information contained in a consumer report" to provide oral, written, or electronic notice to the consumer.
