NEW YORK | PERSONAL INJURY

Self-Created Delay Not Valid Excuse For Untimely Summary Judgment

Plaintiffs, Jeffrey Pollizzotto, deceased, and Luann Pollizzotto, commenced a New York City Asbestos Litigation (NYCAL) personal injury action. The action concerned Mr. Pollizzotto’s alleged asbestos exposure from various defendants’ products which plaintiffs claim caused Mr. Pollizzotto’s lung cancer. Defendants moved for summary judgment. The motion was denied. The court held successor defendant Norton Company’s delay in preparing to move for summary judgment based on its alleged settlement efforts was without merit. A self-created delay with no satisfactory explanation offered to justify it does not constitute good cause. Apart from citing ongoing settlement discussions, Norton offered no other explanation or stated any difficulties that caused its delay in procuring relevant materials from its corporate representative and experts for the motion.

KINGS | MEDICAL MALPRACTICE

Summary Judgment Denied Following Conclusory Statements by Experts

A medical malpractice action involved a patient’s treatment for sepsis and renal obstruction. The defendant hospital moved for summary judgment. The court denied defendant’s motion, holding that their expert affirmation from a critical care physician was conclusory, and they failed to address and rebut the claims in plaintiff’s bill of particulars. Regardless of the movant’s failure to meet the prima facie burden, the court held that plaintiff’s urology expert raised issues of fact and was qualified to opine on the relevant treatment. The court rejected the movant’s arguments in reply, which were not supported by the expert in the initial moving papers.

SECOND CIRCUIT | IMMIGRATION LAW

Bid to Reopen Removal Proceedings Is Revived; BIA Abused Discretion in Denying Petition

Noncitizens who receive a final order of removal from the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) generally have 90 days to file a motion to reopen their removal proceedings. That deadline may be equitably tolled if extraordinary circumstances prevented a timely filing and the movant exercised reasonable diligence throughout the tolling period. An appeal presented the question of what “reasonable diligence” requires when petitioner, after being removed from the U.S., files a motion to reopen based on a change in law that arguably makes him eligible for relief. Petitioner, a Panamanian national and former lawful permanent resident removed in 2011, had sought to reopen after NY vacated his marijuana convictions and intervening case law undermined the removability of his 1993 cocaine conviction, leaving no valid basis for removal if reopened. The BIA denied his untimely motion to reopen, concluding he had not acted with reasonable diligence. The Second Circuit remanded, finding that the BIA abused its discretion by denying petitioner’s untimely motion to reopen for lack of “reasonable diligence” without giving adequate reasons.

U.S. - EDNY | PERSONAL INJURY

Court Dismisses Public Nuisance Class Action Over Parked E-Scooter Sidewalk Injuries

Plaintiff brought a putative class action against shared electronic scooter (e-scooter) companies Bird, Lime, Veo and the City of New York, claiming that improperly parked e-scooters created a public nuisance that caused him to trip and injure himself. The complaint contended that the defendants permitted scooters to block sidewalks, curbs and private property, posing hazards to pedestrians, particularly the elderly and disabled. Defendants moved to dismiss, asserting that plaintiff failed to show a “special injury,” did not identify which company owned the scooters that caused his fall, and could not hold the City of New York liable. The court agreed with defendants, finding that plaintiff did not establish a direct causal connection between defendants’ conduct and his injury and could not hold the e-scooter companies responsible for scooters owned or misused by unidentified third parties. The court dismissed the complaint without prejudice, noting that legislative and regulatory channels, rather than private nuisance claims, are the proper forum to address systemic issues with the e-scooter program.

NEW YORK | CONSUMER PROTECTION

Summary Judgment Denied; Plaintiff Set Forth Claim Under General Business Law § 349

Plaintiff, Jonathan Marra, filed its complaint against defendant alleging breach of contract or warranty for \$50,000 with interest; breach of contract, violation of general business law Section 349 and violation of New York Fair Credit Reporting Act. In support of its motion, defendant argued that plaintiff’s amended complaint failed to state a claim for breach of contract and violation of GBL Section 349 and 381. Plaintiff opposed. The motion was denied. The court held in order to establish a prima facie violation of General Business Law § 349, a plaintiff must demonstrate that a defendant is engaging in consumer-oriented conduct which is deceptive or misleading in a material way, and that the plaintiff has been injured because of it. Consumer-oriented conduct does not require a plaintiff to show that the defendant repeatedly committed the acts complained of. Instead, a plaintiff must demonstrate only that the acts or practices have a broader impact on consumers at large. Plaintiff’s complaint set forth sufficient allegations for a cognizable claim of violation of GBL 349.

Court Finds That Defendant Waived Right To Personal Jurisdiction

In a motion by plaintiff Sabaj Law, P.C., plaintiff sought an order pursuant to CPLR 3125 seeking leave to enter a default judgment against defendant Romotzki and setting the matter down for an inquest in favor of plaintiff. Although the motion was opposed the motion contending that the defendant had a reasonable excuse for failing to timely answer the complaint, had a meritorious defense to the allegations, and that the commencement papers were improperly served to the defendant’s adversary in the lawsuit in which the plaintiff was acting as defendant’s lawyer, the court granted the motion for default judgment and set the matter for an inquest date. The court found the defendant waived any claim to personal jurisdiction when its counsel filed a notice of appearance and neither interposed an answer raising a jurisdictional objection nor made a motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction.

U.S. - SDNY | ADMIRALTY

Sail Charter NYC’s Limitation Petition Dismissed for Lack of Admiralty Jurisdiction

An action arose after a guest allegedly fell into the water while disembarking a docked 1922 Herreshoff vessel at North Cove Marina in Manhattan. Although the court assumed the incident may have occurred on navigable waters and found that transporting and caring for passengers bears a substantial relationship to traditional maritime activity, it concluded that the type of incident, an injury to a passenger while exiting a docked vessel, does not realistically threaten maritime commerce. Relying on Second Circuit precedent including *Tandon v. Captain’s Cove Marina of Bridgeport* and the district court’s reasoning in *Susana v. NY Waterway*, the court held that such dockside accidents, even when the person falls into the water, lack the potential to disrupt commercial shipping and therefore fall outside federal admiralty jurisdiction. The court dismissed Sail Charter NYC LLC’s petition for exoneration from or limitation of liability under the Limitation of Liability Act for lack of admiralty jurisdiction, determining that the underlying personal injury claim did not satisfy the required “connection” to maritime activity.

U.S. - NDNY | CRIMINAL LAW

Defendant Is Remanded to Custody Pending Trial on Multiple Alien Smuggling Charges

Defendant was charged in a criminal indictment with conspiracy to commit alien smuggling and eight counts of alien smuggling. After his arrest by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security – Homeland Security Investigations in December 2025 at LaGuardia Airport, a magistrate judge ordered defendant’s release to his parents under a \$10,000 appearance bond and electronic monitoring. The government appealed, asserting that the defendant was a flight risk due to his ties to India and Canada; his involvement in a people-smuggling scheme; and his attempt to book a last-minute flight from LaGuardia Airport to Canada after learning of the federal arrest warrant. The instant court analyzed the 18 U.S.C. §3142(g) “nature and circumstances of the offense charged” factors and determined that, while defendant did not appear dangerous, the weight of the evidence, potential five-year mandatory minimum sentence, and flight-related conduct heavily favored detention. The court granted the government’s appeal and revoked defendant’s release, remanding him to the custody of the U.S. Marshal pending trial.

NEW YORK | TRUSTS AND ESTATES

Court Orders Public Administrator To Distribute Estate to Niece

After the final accounting in the estate of John Norton, the public administrator requested a determination of the identity of decedent’s distributees. Three alleged distributees appeared in the proceeding: Gisela Sikiu Norton Garcia (Garcia), an alleged niece, Pedro Rohov (Rohov), an alleged maternal first cousin, and Terry Scavezze-Newfield (Newfield), the legal representative for the estate of Jerry H. Newfield, an alleged maternal first cousin, who post-deceased the decedent. Objections were filed by Garcia and Newfield. Five kinship hearings were held before a court attorney-referee. The public administrator was directed to distribute the net estate in accordance with EPTL 4-1.1(a)(5) to Gisela Sikiu Norton Garcia. The court held that more than three years had elapsed since decedent’s death, and that no claim to a distributive share in the estate had been made by any other person other than the respondents who appeared in this proceeding.

RICHMOND | CONTRACTS

Agreement Language in Contract Allows Court to Grant Summary Judgment

Arising from breach of contract and account stated claims matter, plaintiff moved for summary judgment, seeking judgment on the causes of action sounding in breach of contract and account stated, dismissal with prejudice of defendants’ affirmative defenses and counterclaims, and an award of interest and attorneys’ fees. Plaintiff’s evidence consisted of the sworn affirmation of his Credit Associate (CA), who was responsible for overseeing and managing customer credit accounts and was intimately familiar with the manner and method by which plaintiff created and maintained its books and records, including computer records of credit accounts. The motion was granted. The court held that plaintiff established entitlement to an award of reasonable attorneys’ fees pursuant to the agreement language quoted in the parties’ submissions. To ensure the fee component was determined with requisite rigor and adversarial fairness, plaintiff was ordered to submit a fee application within 30 days after service of the decision with notice of entry and defendant to submit objections within 21 days after service of plaintiff’s fee application.

U.S. - SDNY | INSURANCE LAW

Court Rules on Insurance Coverage Dispute Over Salmonella-Contaminated Parsley

High Quality Organics (HQO), a supplier of organic herbs and spices, discovered that its parsley had tested positive for salmonella, prompting customer Red Monkey Foods (RMF) to issue a product recall and demand over \$1 million in damages. HQO sought coverage from its insurers, Berkley Assurance Co. and AXIS Insurance Co., but AXIS denied coverage, asserting that it had no obligations under the policy it had issued to HQO because RMF had not sued HQO and because the policy did not provide coverage for RMF’s damages. Berkley then filed a declaratory judgment action against AXIS and HQO, and HQO cross-claimed seeking a ruling that AXIS must cover the loss. The court held that RMF’s demand letter and the amount at stake created a practical likelihood of litigation, so it had jurisdiction to consider AXIS’s duty to defend. However, because no suit has been filed, that duty has not been triggered, and the court therefore granted AXIS summary judgment on that issue. The court dismissed the claims concerning AXIS’s duty to indemnify and declined to exercise jurisdiction over those claims, finding no sufficient showing that HQO would become legally obligated to pay RMF.
