NEW YORK | TRUSTS AND ESTATES

Court Allows Allocation of Medical Malpractice Settlement Agreement

The court granted an unopposed petition by Robert Roach, as administrator of the estate of decedent Tara Roach, to allocate and account for the proceeds of the compromise of causes of action for medical malpractice leading to her pain and suffering and untimely death, against a hospital and two doctors. The court held its order directed payment of a sum to decedent's health insurer, through her Union, for an ERISA lien. It also fixed attorney's fees and disbursements which became payable upon the filing of this proceeding. The court also allocated the settlement as requested, 40% to the claims for conscious pain and suffering and 60% to the claims for wrongful death.

QUEENS | CRIMINAL LAW

Dismissal of Criminal Action Denied; Prosecutions' Discovery Requirements Fulfilled

Defendant, in a criminal action, made an omnibus motion for inspection of the Grand Jury minutes and dismissal; suppression of statement evidence; suppression of identification evidence; preclusion of statement evidence; preclusion of identification evidence; disclosure of vicious or immoral acts and a Sandoval hearing; any and all Brady and Rosario material; and invalidation of the Queen's District Attorney's Office's certificate of compliance. The part of defendant's motion seeking dismissal was denied. The court held the People exercised due diligence and made reasonable efforts to both identify and disclose mandatory discovery prior to filing their certificate of compliance.

SECOND CIRCUIT | CIVIL PROCEDURE

Court Lacks Subject Matter Jurisdiction Over State-Law Claims Regarding Federal Tax Code

This action arose out of a complex dispute involving asserted breaches of state law. Plaintiff alleged these breaches occurred when defendant calculated a purchase price that excluded exit taxes allegedly contemplated by Internal Revenue Code §42. Plaintiff sued in federal court for breach of fiduciary duty, professional negligence, unjust enrichment, and fraud, claiming federal jurisdiction lies as the interpretation of the appropriate section of the federal tax code is, ultimately, a matter of federal law. The district court ruled plaintiff failed to implicate federal interests so as to arise under federal law. The Second Circuit affirmed, agreeing the court lacked subject matter jurisdiction as plaintiff's claims do not fall within the "special and small category" of state-law claims that present significant federal issues. The panel noted that even if plaintiff's claims had raised questions of federal tax law, these claims are unlikely to have the sort of significance for the federal system that is required to establish federal jurisdiction, and exercising federal jurisdiction here would disturb the accepted balance of state and federal responsibilities.

U.S. - SDNY | EDUCATION LAW

Mother Granted Summary Judgment on Independent Educational Evaluation Claim Against DOE

Plaintiff, on behalf of daughter R.N., sued the NYC Dep't of Education (DOE) defendants, alleging they violated the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and owe plaintiff reimbursement for the cost of private school tuition; transportation to and from school; and one-one-one nursing services for part of the 2023-2024 extended school year. Plaintiff further demanded the DOE pay for an Independent Educational Evaluation (IEE) for R.N. The court denied plaintiff's motion for summary judgment as to her tuition and related services claims. However, the court noted that plaintiff's attorney sent a document to the DOE in 2023 entitled "due process complaint" that includes a section on the insufficiency of the evaluations the DOE had ordered for R.N., and the DOE did not dispute the fact that plaintiff voiced her disagreement with the DOE evaluations in her due process complaint. Since this lack of pre-complaint notice was the sole basis for the Impartial Hearing Officer's and State Review Officer's determinations, and defendants did not provide any other argument for why an IEE was not appropriate for R.N., the court granted plaintiff summary judgment on her IEE claim.

KINGS | MEDICAL MALPRACTICE

Motion to Dismiss Granted in Medical Malpractice Action

Plaintiff, as proposed administrator of a deceased person's estate, brought a prior medical malpractice action against defendants which were dismissed for lack of capacity. Within six months of the first dismissal, they commenced a second action. Defendants moved to dismiss the second action because plaintiff still had not obtained letters of administration. In opposition, plaintiff argued the second dismissal should be without prejudice to another six-month period to revive their claims. Defendants' motion was granted. The court held that only the wrongful death claim, which was still timely when the second action was commenced, may be revived again under CPLR 205(a).

QUEENS | CONTRACTS

Lack of Reasonable Delay Allows Court To Deny Default Judgment

Plaintiff stated causes of action based upon breach of contract and an account stated. Plaintiff moved for summary judgment. The motion was denied. The court held the plaintiff's excuse for the delay of over 4 years in seeking default was a confluence of law office failures including staff turnover, inability to hire, office delays due to high case volume, failure to calendar and case backlogs did not hold up. The court found that plaintiff's layered, omnibus excuses were conclusory, unsubstantiated and undemonstrative of typical law office failure. The court found pursuant to the absence of a reasonable excuse for the delay, it was unnecessary for the court to consider whether the plaintiff sufficiently demonstrated a potentially meritorious action.

U.S. - SDNY | DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Plaintiff Seeking Injunction Over Arbitration Before JAMS Fails to Show Irreparable Harm

Pro se plaintiff filed five actions that have been consolidated, all of which relate to arbitration before defendant JAMS Inc. or litigation in Texas state court in connection with contracts with defendant Tenet Healthcare and its subsidiaries VHS Harlingen Hospital Company LLC and Valley Baptist Realty Company LLC. Plaintiff sought a nationwide injunction enjoining JAMS "from initiating, continuing, or administering any arbitration proceedings against any individual or entity within the United States until federal regulators determine whether JAMS has engaged in systemic misconduct." Plaintiff stated that his May 2025 arbitration will occur "despite acknowledged time-barred claims and lack of contractual privity." The instant court denied plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief, concluding that plaintiff failed to demonstrate irreparable harm. Specifically, the court determined that plaintiff failed to present any more details about the arbitration; what the underlying claims are or why they are time-barred; who the other parties in the arbitration are; what issues the arbitration agreement covers; or why there is no contractual privity.

U.S. - EDNY | EMPLOYMENT LITIGATION

HSBC Employee Fails to Show She Was Dismissed For Gender or Pregnancy Discrimination

Plaintiff sued her former employer, defendant HSBC Bank USA N.A., alleging discrimination based on gender and pregnancy in violation of the New York State Human Rights Law and the New York City Human Rights Law. Plaintiff was terminated after she and 24 other HSBC employees were disciplined in connection with HSBC's internal investigation into unethical sales practices. The court granted defendant's motion for summary judgment, determining that plaintiff failed to produce sufficient evidence of gender or pregnancy discrimination since she failed to adduce any evidence capable of persuading a reasonable jury that her gender or pregnancy played a role in her termination. The court further added that HSBC dismissed seven employees, four men and three women, including plaintiff, for violating its policies. The court found no evidence that any of these dismissed employees besides plaintiff was pregnant and, therefore, HSBC subjected six employees outside plaintiff's protected class to the same disciplinary action for the same conduct as plaintiff, which undermines her discrimination claim.

QUEENS | CIVIL RIGHTS

Dismissal of Civil Rights Action Granted; Plaintiff Failed to Raise Issue of Fact

Plaintiff brought a civil rights action against the City of New York, a named individual New York City police officer, a New York State parole officer, and "John Doe" NYPD officers, claiming a violation of his rights under Civil Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. Sections 1983 and 1988; his Fourth, Fifth and 14th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution; as well as the laws of the State of New York. Defendants made a motion for summary judgment. Among other things, the individual officer contended that NYS parole officers arrested and searched plaintiff before NYPD's arrival to the scene and that she was entitled to qualified immunity and was not named in the Notice of Claim. The motion was granted. The court held it was unclear which portion of the complaint the plaintiff was referring to as false as an argument against defendants. Thus, the plaintiff failed to raise a triable issue of fact.

SUFFOLK | FAMILY LAW

Court Upholds Foreign Divorce Judgment; No Lack of Due Process Found

The parties were married and subsequently divorced by Judgment of the Court of First Instance 19th Chamber, Republic and Canton of Geneva. The plaintiff, in support of his application, submitted the foreign Judgment divorcing the parties. The Judgment of Divorce translated into English was accompanied by a Certification of Translation Accuracy. Plaintiff's application sought recognition of the foreign judgment to facilitate the issuance of a Domestic Relations Order in the State dividing his retirement plan for Officers of Columbia University for which he was a participant. The application was granted. The court held the foreign Judgment of Divorce entered in Courts of Switzerland was recognized in New York under the Doctrine of Comity, as there was no showing of lack of due process or offense to the public policy of the State.

U.S. - SDNY | EMPLOYMENT LITIGATION

Court Grants Default Judgment to Plaintiff Over Former Employer's FLSA, NYLL Violations

Plaintiff sued defendant corporation, which owns and operates a resale business selling houseware and other items, alleging violations of the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) and the New York Labor Law (NYLL). Plaintiff, who was employed as a clerk by defendant in 2024, sought damages, including back wages, liquidated damages, statutory damages, pre- and post-judgment interest, and attorneys' fees and costs, in connection with his claims for violations of unpaid minimum and overtime wages under FLSA and NYLL, and wage notice and statement provisions of NYLL. The court granted plaintiff's motion for default judgment, determining that defendant was plaintiff's employer under both the FLSA and the NYLL; defendant violated the NYLL's minimum wage provisions; defendant violated the FLSA and NYLL overtime requirements; and defendant violated the NYLL's wage notice and wage statement provisions. Noting the total amount that plaintiff should have received in a given week, including both standard and overtime pay, the court found that plaintiff is owed \$17,348.57 in back wages under the NYLL, with 9% prejudgment interest, and liquidated damages in the amount of \$17,348.57.
