DECISIONS OF INTEREST

NEW YORK | LITIGATION

Despite Extreme Delay; Court Dismisses Case Of Unauthorized Sending of Funds

Plaintiff brought a case to recover \$25,000 that it claims it inadvertently sent to defendant, a law firm, in connection with a federal copyright action. It alleged that as part of the settlement in that action, plaintiff agreed to pay \$25,000 to Dress Barn through an IOLA trust account maintained by defendant – the defendant was never the plaintiff’s lawyer. Plaintiff asserted that, in error, it issued two checks to defendant. It claimed it reached out to defendant and, after being told that defendant would look into it, never heard back nor did it receive the money back. Plaintiff moved for a default judgment on the ground that defendant never answered or otherwise timely responded. Defendant subsequently moved to dismiss the three causes of action. Default judgment was denied and dismissal was granted. The court held plaintiff suffered no prejudice from defendant’s delay in answering. Likewise, all three causes of action failed which required dismissal of the complaint.

NEW YORK | CIVIL PROCEDURE

Court Grants Defendants’ Request To Seal/Redact Purchase and Sale Agreement

Defendants Coco Hotel 1 LLC and Coco Condominium 1 LLC moved to seal/redact a March 25, 2025 Purchase and Sale Agreement (PSA) entered into by the parties. Specifically, defendants argued that the PSA contained competitively sensitive and proprietary business information regarding the property at issue and the purchase transaction’s structure, which disclosed could harm defendants’ interest, including any future sale of the property. Plaintiffs took no position as to the proposed redactions. There was no indication that the press or public had an interest in the matter. The motion was granted. The court held the proposed redactions/sealings were warranted to protect defendants from competitive harm in future sales negotiations, especially since there was no public interest in these documents.

KINGS | CREDITORS’ AND DEBTORS’ RIGHTS

Summary Judgment Granted for Plaintiff in Credit Card Debt Action

Plaintiff moved for summary action and defendant cross-moved to dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction in this action on credit card debt. Defendant disputed plaintiff’s evidence on the motion but the court held that the affidavit of plaintiff’s employee did lay a sufficient foundation for the admission of Plaintiff’s business records. Defendant’s position was inconsistent. The court granted summary judgment to plaintiff. As for personal jurisdiction, the process server affirmed that a Hamza Ahmed, describing himself as a co-resident, had been served at defendant’s apartment and the summons and complaint were also mailed. Defendant acknowledged receiving the papers by mail but argued that she did not know anyone by the name of Hamza Ahmed, and no one matching the description of the person served would have been at her home, nor would anyone have described themselves as her co-resident.

U.S. - SDNY | CONSUMER PROTECTION

PFAS Class Action Dismissed for Failure To Allege Purchase of Misbranded Products

Plaintiff, an individual consumer of Procter & Gamble (P&G) products, including Oral-B Glide products, brought a putative class action against P&G, alleging deceptive and false advertising practices in violation of New York General Business Law §§349 and 350. Plaintiff specifically contended that certain P&G’s Oral-B Glide dental floss products are misleadingly branded on their packaging as “Pro-Health” despite containing per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), a group of chemicals known to be harmful to humans and the environment. Plaintiff asserted that he would not have purchased Oral-B Glide products, or paid a premium for them, had he known they contained dangerous and unsustainable PFAS. P&G moved to dismiss the Second Amended Complaint for lack of standing and failure to state a claim. The court granted P&G’s motion to dismiss, without prejudice, determining that plaintiff failed to plausibly allege that he purchased products containing PFAS or that the products were misbranded, and therefore could not demonstrate a concrete, particularized economic injury under either a price-premium or benefit-of-the-bargain theory.

NEW YORK | MEDICAL MALPRACTICE

Motion to Vacate Note of Issue Denied; Summary Judgment Deadline Extended

In an action to recover damages for medical malpractice based on alleged departures from good and accepted practice and lack of informed consent, the defendants move pursuant to 22 NYCRR 202.21(e) to vacate the note of issue and certificate of readiness, and pursuant to CPLR 2004 to extend their time for moving for summary judgment. The defendant also asked for HIPPA authorizations. The plaintiff opposed the motion. The court extended the deadline to move for summary judgment and for the authorizations, but denied the rest of the motion. The court held under the circumstances presented in the action, in which the plaintiff was represented by counsel, as opposed to appearing pro se, the court rejected the plaintiff’s contention that it would be overly burdensome for her attorney to prepare the authorizations for her signature before delivering them to the defendants’ attorneys.

NEW YORK | LANDLORD TENANT LAW

Court Allows Respondent Discovery For Alleged Overcharge Claim

Petitioner commenced this summary nonpayment proceeding in March 2024. Respondent Nigel Dixon appeared by counsel and answered in October 2024. The petitioner initially filed a motion to amend its petition and strike respondent’s overcharge claim. Respondent filed a cross motion in opposition and for discovery based on an overcharge claim. The court granted the petitioner’s motion to amend the petitioner, but petitioner’s motion for discovery was also granted. The court found that respondent’s allegations of unexplained increases, a preferential rent scheme, and an unexplained rent reduction order were sufficient to maintain respondent’s overcharge claim and satisfied the *Farkas* factors.

U.S. - SDNY | CRIMINAL LAW

Court Quashes Broad Instagram Subpoenas, Partially Upholds Communications Request

In 2025, defendants’ counsel served largely identical subpoenas duces tecum on three alleged victims in this case (Victims 1, 2, and 6). Each of those subpoenas was substantially the same, as they all sought broad categories of content and data associated with each respective victims’ Instagram accounts. Several days later, defendants’ counsel served additional subpoenas on two alleged victims. Although not quite as cut-and-paste as the Instagram subpoenas, each of the new subpoenas sought communications between the respective victim and some of her friends “regarding” defendants and/or the trips to the Hamptons where the alleged assaults occurred. Victim 1 moved to quash both of defendants’ subpoenas, arguing that many of the requests are irrelevant to the case or otherwise constitute an overbroad fishing expedition. The court largely agreed with all victims seeking to quash the subpoenas but, among other things, partially upheld the communications subpoena served on Victim 2, finding that defendants failed to identify any specifically relevant and admissible communications beyond possible impeachment material.

U.S. - SDNY | INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Court Allows Lanham Act False-Advertising Claim, Dismisses Tortious-Interference Claim

Plaintiffs brought an action against defendant LY Berditchev Corp., contending that LY Berditchev’s sale of KLAIRE LABS and POWERSTEP products on Amazon violated federal false-advertising and state tortious-interference laws. Plaintiffs asserted that the products were misleadingly labeled as “new” under Amazon guidelines, since the original manufacturer’s warranties did not apply to purchases from unauthorized resellers. The court determined that plaintiffs plausibly alleged a false-advertising claim under the Lanham Act and denied the motion to dismiss on that count, finding that LY Berditchev’s listings designating Advertised Products as “new” could plausibly mislead consumers under Amazon’s rules. However, the court dismissed plaintiffs’ tortious-interference claim, reasoning that plaintiffs failed to identify a specific contractual breach by the manufacturers, which is a necessary element of that claim. Further, the court found that the complaint did not cite any provision in the manufacturers’ contracts with plaintiffs that had been violated, and without such allegations, that claim could not proceed.

Front Row Group v. LY Berditchev Corp., 25-cv-1307 (January 22)

NEW YORK | MEDICAL MALPRACTICE

Court Grants Change of Venue from New York County to Richmond County

Plaintiff filed an amended complaint alleging that Dr. Daniel Megna negligently caused an intestinal perforation during a colonoscopy performed at a medical facility operated by Sottile & Megna, M.D. in Richmond County. Following the procedure, plaintiff sought further medical treatment at a hospital owned and operated by defendants New York and Presbyterian Hospital. Defendants moved for an order to change venue from New York County to Richmond County. The motion was granted. The court held the record reflected that defendant maintained its principal executive office in Richmond County, and the alleged negligent acts by Dr. Megna occurred at that location. Furthermore, plaintiff resided in Richmond County at the time of commencement. The court that Richmond County was the proper venue for the matter.

DVSJA Resentencing Dismissals Without Prejudice Are Appealable; Denial Affirmed

Defendant was convicted of manslaughter in the first degree and sentenced to 20 years’ imprisonment. In 2022, she moved to be resentenced in accordance with the Domestic Violence Survivors Justice Act (DVSJA). The lower court, without a hearing, dismissed the motion without prejudice based on defendant’s failure to provide corroboration that she was a victim of ongoing domestic violence at the time of the offense. The Second Department affirmed the order, rejecting a contrary ruling from the Third Department in holding that an order dismissing without prejudice a defendant’s application for resentencing under CPL 440.47 and the DVSJA is appealable as of right. The panel reasoned that such dismissal effectively constitutes a denial of resentencing within the meaning of CPL 440.47(3)(a) and that the Legislature could not have intended to insulate these threshold determinations from appellate review. On the merits, however, the court affirmed dismissal, as defendant failed to submit the required corroborating evidence showing she was a victim of domestic violence at the time of the offense, as required by CPL 440.47(2)(c).

U.S. - SDNY | ANTITRUST

Court Upholds Sherman Act Claims Against Google for Ad Servers and Ad Exchanges

Rumble Canada sued Google and Alphabet under the Sherman Act, alleging monopolization, attempted monopolization, unlawful tying, and restraint of trade related to online advertising. Rumble publishes user-submitted videos online and generates revenue by selling display ads shown alongside these videos as well as “instream” video ads that appear within the videos themselves. Rumble sells display ads via Google’s ad server and utilizes Google’s ad-exchange product. Rumble alleged Google maintained monopoly power in ad servers and ad exchanges through product ties, restrictive policies, and preferential deals with competitors like Facebook. Among other things, the court held that Rumble plausibly alleged antitrust standing to assert monopolization, attempted monopolization, and tying claims, but only in the markets for ad servers and ad exchanges. However, the court found that Rumble failed to plausibly allege a monopolization, attempted monopolization, or unlawful tying claim directed to the market for instream online video advertising. Further, the court concluded that Rumble did not plausibly allege that the parties’ “Network Bidding Agreement” was a restraint of trade.
