Upon consideration of the Judicial Qualifications Commission's Findings and Recommendations of Discipline and the parties' Stipulation, the Court rejects the Stipulation and disapproves the proposed sanction. In addition to the public reprimand agreed to in the Stipulation, the Court would impose a fine. Should the parties agree to the imposition of a fine in addition to a public reprimand, a revised Findings and Recommendations of Discipline and revised Stipulation should be filed with the Court within 30 days of the date of this order.

If the parties do not agree to these terms, the parties must inform the Court within 30 days that they have not reached an agreement. In that event, this case will be returned for a hearing before the Judicial Qualifications Commission.
