DECISIONS OF INTEREST

APP. DIV. | INSURANCE LITIGATION

Settlement Agreement, Consent Judgment Only Assigned Right to Enforce Judgment

Vola Corp. operated a nightclub/restaurant. In a federal action, models and social influencers claimed Vola improperly and knowingly used their images in advertising without their consent or payment. Insurers Hudson Excess and Lancer Indem. Corp. denied Vola defense or indemnification. Under a later settlement of the Vola Action, Vola assigned to the instant plaintiffs its right to pursue coverage claims against Hudson and Lancer. Supreme court in Manhattan denied plaintiffs a declaration that Hudson had a duty to defend an indemnify, but granted a declaration that Lancer had a duty to defend. The court dismissed plaintiffs' claims against Hudson. Otherwise upholding supreme court's judgment, First Department denied Lancer's cross-motion to dismiss plaintiffs' claims against it as to the duty to indemnify. The settlement and consent judgment did not relieve Lancer of legal liability. Thus, supreme court should not have found that Lancer had no duty to indemnify. However, neither the settlement agreement nor the consent judgment constituted an admission of liability against Lancer, only the right to attempt to enforce judgment against Lancer.

Court Grants Motion Following Defendant's Failure to File Opposition

In an action by Midland Funding LLC against Denise Cullen, plaintiff moved by notice of motion for an order to compel defendant to respond to plaintiff's interrogatories. The court rendered a decision granting the motion on default and directing defendant to respond to plaintiff's discovery demands. Plaintiff moved seeking an order striking defendant's answer and allowing plaintiff to enter judgment before the Court Clerk. The motion was granted. The court held defendant did not file any opposition or proffer any evidence demonstrating any attempt to comply with the Court Order.

Motion to Dismiss Granted In Criminal Case

The defendant had been detained by immigration custody (ICE) for over a year. Prior to his detention, he had pled guilty to a misdemeanor. Despite numerous attempts he was not returned to NY for sentence, defendant moved for dismissal pursuant to CPL § 380.30. The motion was granted. Appellate authority was scant for the court and the statute didn't define the length of delay required for dismissal. The court applied its own interpretation given the facts. While a delay due to ongoing legal proceedings in the ICE Court would be excusable, no evidence had been presented by the government that any hearing had been scheduled or held. Or, that any impediment existed to returning the defendant to New York to be sentenced.

U.S. - SDNY | DISCOVERY

Court Explains Why It Lacks Jurisdiction To Modify, Quash Subpoena in Suit Over Wages

Defendant DiPilato owned Alphonso's Pizzeria where Vargas worked for five years, until February 202021 without ever being paid overtime or spread-of-hours pay. Johnson bought the pizzeria in August 2022 after DiPilato filed for personal bankruptcy. On Oct. 25, 2024, Vargas applied for a discovery subpoena on Johnson's email account, to be served on Google in Santa Clara County, California, where Google is located. Vargas claimed that 2,000 emails and text messages in the account detailed the pizzeria's continued operation by DiPilato while creating the false impression of a legitimate transfer to an innocent new owner. Vargas also claimed that Johnson used the Google account to cover up the relationship with DiPilato. District court denied Johnson's motion to quash the subpoena. The SDNY is not the district where Google's compliance with the subpoena is required. Google's principal place of business is not within 100 miles of the SDNY. Thus, under FRCP 45(d)(3) the instant court lacked jurisdiction to modify or quash the subject subpoena.

NEW YORK | TRUSTS AND ESTATES

Court Allows Verified Claim Despite Party Not Being Served

Party East 70" Street Apartment Corp. moved to be allowed to file a verified claim nunc pro tunc against the estate of Maude Davis for unpaid rent in the amount of \$81,739.92. The executor of the will, Eva Beale, had not filed any opposition to the request. The motion was granted. The court held the executor had actual knowledge of the claim before her appointment and thus could not avail herself to the protections of SCPA 1802 even though E 70th St Corp had not served her with a verified claim.

Court Orders Husband to Pay \$4,312.50 In Child Support

Plaintiff-wife brought an absolute divorce against defendant-husband. Parties entered into a settlement on the issue of child custody and access. A trial was held. Plaintiff argued that the Husband should be imputed income based on his suspicious income tax filings as it pertained to his Schedule C deductions. Plaintiff also argued that the child support statutory cap should be adjusted above the \$183,000 threshold given the imputed income to the Husband, notwithstanding the parties had both physical custody of the children. Plaintiff prevailed on both issues. The court imputed the husbands income to be \$500,000 after consideration of suspicious tax filings and ordered the husband to pay \$4,312.50 of monthly support.

SECOND CIRCUIT | IMMIGRATION LAW

Noncitizens Adjusting to LPR Status Must Maintain Current Asylum Status

Petitions for review, argued in tandem, asked whether noncitizens seeking to adjust status to become lawful permanent residents under 8 USC §1159(b) must maintain their current asylum status or whether noncitizens may adjust even if their asylum status has been terminated. Second Circuit denied the petitions for review. It agreed with the Board of Immigration Appeals that the plain text of §1159(b) allows only noncitizens with current asylum status to adjust to lawful permanent resident status. Thus, because their asylum had been terminated petitioners Wassily and Velasquez Arreaga could not adjust to lawful permanent resident status under 8 USC §1159(b). A grant of asylum does not convey the right to remain permanently in the United States. Second Circuit was not free to alter the plain meaning of §1159(b) based on a nebulous idea that some greater degree of waiver authority under 8 USC §1159(c) would be preferable as a matter of policy. Such request is better addressed to Congress.

Denial of Temporary Release From MDC To Prepare for Trial Is Explained

July 2023 indictment charged both defendants with wire and investment advisor fraud, money laundering, and other crimes for defrauding elderly and disabled victims of at least \$5 million. Defendant Adam Kaplan (Kaplan) is now defending a Feb. 20, 2025, superseding indictment following revocation of bail. Kaplan is detained in Brooklyn's Metropolitan Detention Center (MDC) awaiting trial, set to start on Sept. 8, 2025. The court denied his instant motion for temporary release pursuant to 18 USC §3142(i)—rarely used—to adequately prepare for his imminent trial. The court denied Kaplan's motion; he did not show that temporary release was "necessary for preparation of his defense or for another compelling reason." Kaplan twice previously violated the conditions of his release on bail. The court also noted that Kaplan has already been provided at least 11 months, since discovery in October 2023, prior to his bail revocation. Here, the court found multiple suitable methods for Kaplan to review discovery. Because Kaplan is a danger to the community, the MDC's conditions were not a compelling reason to allow temporary release.

BRONX | CRIMINAL LAW

Motion to Dismiss Criminal Charges Denied; Prosecution Acted With Due Diligence

Defendant was charged with Vehicle and Traffic Law § 1192[2-a][a] and related charges. Defendant moved for dismissal of the accusatory instrument alleging that the prosecution's certificate of compliance ("COC") was invalid. Defendant argued that the prosecution did not disclose discoverable items prior to the COC's filing, including the Medical Treatment of Prisoner Form, a complete copy of the Intoxicated Driver Report, property vouchers, chain of custody reports, and the Interrogation Warnings Form. Defendant further argued that the prosecution did not turn over the names and contact information for FDNY personnel who treated Defendant at the scene. The prosecution opposed. The motion was denied. The court found that the prosecution exercised due diligence and made reasonable inquiries and efforts to obtain and disclose discoverable items prior to the COC's filing. The court assessed the prosecution's diligence using the relevant factors outlined in C.P.L. § 245.50[5], one of the newly enacted provisions of C.P.L. Article 245. The court found that the contact information for FDNY personnel who treated Defendant at the scene was not automatically discoverable.

WESTCHESTER | CIVIL PROCEDURE

Court Denies Issuance of Extreme Risk Protection Order Against Respondent

Petitioner filed an application p for an Extreme Risk Protection Order (ERPO), which would preclude respondent from possessing or purchasing a firearm for one year. After a hearing held on August 5, 2025, the court found that petitioner had failed to meet its burden to proven by clear and convincing evidence that the respondent was likely to engage in conduct that would result in serious harm to self or others as defined in Mental Hygiene Law § 9.39(a) and denied the petitioner's application for an ERPO, dismissed the petition and vacated the Temporary ERPO (TERPO) in place. There was no evidence in the record that respondent manifested "violent" behavior, placing others "in reasonable fear of serious physical harm." The ERPO application itself stated that respondent's references on Facebook had not indicated a threat of violence and appear to be motivated to cause reputational damage.

U.S. - SDNY | CRIMINAL LAW

Sentence Is Reduced to Time Served; Recidivism Risk, Threat to Society Greatly Reduced

Hall is serving a 40-year sentence for his participation in the violent "Young Guns" drug-trafficking gang. He is expected to be released in 2037. Three prior applications for compassionate release were denied. His third asserted diagnosis with an advanced form of cancer constituting an exceptional, compelling reason for sentence reduction. Hall's instant fourth motion for sentence reduction under 18 USC §3582(c)(1)(A) claims substantially worsened medical condition, and that only palliative care remains available until his likely death in 18 months or less. Granting Hall's motion, the court reduced sentence to time served, conditioned on development of a detailed plan for his release satisfactory to the Probation Office. The court noted that Hall's shortened life expectancy and treatment regimen greatly reduced the risk of Hall's recidivism and threat to society. Also, recent incidents with prison medical staff—who routinely ignored Hall's pronounced symptoms and delayed diagnosis and treatment—indicating his resistance to, and frustration by, medical treatment, did not involve violence.
