NARRATIVE

On 10/1/2025 I was assigned to the 543 unit. At 9:07pm I responded to Temple Beth Zion for a report of a person with a gun. Other units responding included the 566 unit Detective Lieutenant Sutherland, the 1054 unit Detective Wagner, 567 and 568 units Detectives Danforth and McCarthy, the 551 unit Sergeant Crapo, the 541 unit Officer Miczek, the 542 unit Officer Choedzin, the 544 Officer Ramos, the Coolidge Corner Officer Yung, and the 555 unit Officers Armenti and Yocum. Body worn cameras were activated on arrival.

Detective Wagner was first on scene and spoke with the private security guards assigned to the Temple for it's Yom Kippur service. Signal Security Guard Elijah O'Haver was in possession of the suspect's pellet rifle and informed Detective Wagner that the suspect had just ran into 1574 Beacon St. Detective Wagner approached the residence and was met by the suspect, Carlos Gouvea. Mr. Gouvea was compliant and escorted to the sidewalk where he was handcuffed by Officer Miczek and read his Miranda Rights by Detective Wagner.

Mr. Gouvea admitted to using the pellet rifle to hunt rats in the area. He was advised that it was unsafe to do so and to be aware of the alarm he had caused.

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NARRATIVE

I then spoke with Signal Security Guards O'Haver and Holness. Mr. O'Haver stated that he heard at least two loud shots fired. He then looked uphill and saw Mr. Gouvea behind a large tree holding the pellet rifle. He approached the suspect and he set the rifle down against the tree. Mr. O'Haver attempted to detain the suspect and the two began to get in a brief physical struggle falling to the ground after Mr. Gouvea lunged towards the rifle. The suspect then ran into his residence at [REDACTED]. It was at this time Brookline Police Units arrived on scene.

Carlos Gouvea was placed under arrest, transported to the police station and processed by the 555 unit. He was booked and advised of his constitutional rights by Lieutenant Gruber.

Following transport, Officers noticed that the front passenger side window of Mass. Registration [REDACTED] was shattered with what appeared a hole caused by a projectile in the glass (photos of the damage attached to this report). The vehicle was parked directly in front of 1572 Beacon Street, directly next door to the Temple. The owner of the vehicle, [REDACTED], arrived on scene and unlocked the vehicle, Officer Ramos located what is believed to be the metal pellet round that was fired by Mr. Gouvea inside the passenger side front window (photos of the pellet round attached to this report). Mr. Clouse was provided with this case number for insurance purposes.

The pellet rifle and spent round have been secured and submitted to evidence locker #5.

Mr. Gouvea is being charged with:

- Illegally Discharging a BB/Pellet Gun (269:12B), for shooting a pellet gun over the public sidewalk on Beacon Street, a well traveled walkway endangering the public.
- Disorderly Conduct (272:53), for possessing a pellet rifle in close proximity to a Temple during a service, and discharging the pellet rifle causing alarm due to the hazard.
- Disturbing the Peace (272:53), for possessing a pellet rifle in close proximity to a Temple during a service, and discharging the pellet rifle causing alarm due to the hazard, objectively annoying conduct that annoyed the public and security guards at the Temple.
- Malicious Damage of Personal Property (266:126A), for shattering the window of a parked motor vehicle by discharging a pellet rifle over a public sidewalk and striking the window.

An Application for Criminal Complaint has been filed with Brookline District Court.
